Evening activities and venues

Please join us on Monday at 19:30 for a cocktail dinner that will be served at Patio de San Eulogio. After dinner we will head to the Mosque-Cathedral for a private visit and a concert of sacred music by Capella Cordubensis. The Patio de San Eulogio is less than 5 minutes from the Mosque-Cathedral, at Calle Torrijos, 12 (Córdoba).

The visit to the Mosque-Cathedral starts at 21:00 sharp, so we kindly ask you to be very punctual. This QR will help you to get to the Patio de San Eulogio:



At 19:30 on Tuesday we shall enjoy a cocktail dinner at Casa Palacio Bandolero. The evening will end with a concert of fusion flamenco-Arabic music.

The main entrance to the restaurant is only a few steps from the Palacio de Congresos, at Calle Torrijos, 6 (Córdoba).

Finally, on Wednesday we will host the conference's gala dinner, which will start at 20:00 at the Real Círculo de la Amistad de Córdoba, located at Calle Alfonso XII, 14 (Córdoba).

The Real Círculo de la Amistad is located within a nice 15-minute walk from any of the recommended hotels that will take you through Córdoba's old and modern city center. This QR will help you to get to the venue:



If for some reason you would rather not walk to the gala dinner, there will be two shuttle buses leaving Hotel Hesperia for the Real Círculo de la Amistad at 19:30. The same buses will drive back to Hotel Hesperia after dinner. As the number of seats is limited, if you wish to use the bus, please let our staff know as of Monday at the Audiovisual Secretary located on Floor 0 of the Palacio de Congresos de Córdoba.

Dress code

Conference sessions: business casual.

Gala dinner: cocktail attire.

Men are kindly advised to wear suits or dress shirts and jackets.
